The County has provided this response regarding the planting of trees/landscaping between the sidewalk and street:

"In order for trees/landscaping to be installed within the County right-of-way, a Right-Of-Way Use Agreement is required to be entered into with the County prior to obtaining a permit. A requirement of the Use Agreement is to carry a \$1,000,000.00 General Liability Insurance Policy which typically a homeowner is unable to obtain. Per section 86-67(a) of Our Code 'It shall be unlawful for any person to construct any improvement or any part of an improvement within a right-of-way or easement dedicated to the county without a valid right-of-way/easement permit issued for such construction or providing the appropriate bond for activities under the provision of this article...'"
